#### **RECYCLE COSMETIC & DENTAL PACKAGING**

Unfortunately, many items aren't widely accepted in recycling collections, often because they're made of several different materials and this makes them hard to process. If you're not sure what to do with cosmetics packaging, check out the [Boots cosmetics recycling scheme](#). If you take five empty pieces of cosmetics or dental packaging into a participating store, you'll get 500 Boots Advantage Card points (worth £5) next time you spend £10 or more. You'll have to register online first to participate in the scheme.
